What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live online casino video game reveal hosted by a **Bitz** passionate, real-life presenter. The video game is transmitted from a modern studio equipped with vibrant, colorful sets that evoke a carnival or television game reveal environment.

The centerpiece of the video game is an enormous, vertically installed wheel containing 54 sectors. Players put bets on where they believe the wheel will stop after a spin. Nevertheless, what sets Crazy Time apart from standard wheel games-- like Evolution's own *Dream Catcher*-- is the addition of a Top Slot multiplier and 4 unique, highly immersive perk games.

Understanding the Wheel Segments and Bets

To play Crazy Time efficiently, players should first understand the wagering design. The 54 segments on the wheel are divided into number bets and bonus offer game bets. Each segment uses different payout potentials and probabilities.

Number Bets

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel. Payment: 1:1
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel. Payout: 2:1
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel. Payout: 5:1
- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Payout: 10:1

Perk Game Bets

- **Coin Flip:** Appears 4 times on the wheel.

- **Money Hunt:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears 1 time on the wheel.

The Top Slot Feature

Before every single spin of the primary wheel, a mini two-reel slots located above the primary wheel spins simultaneously.

- **How it Works:** The left reel displays among the betting alternatives (numbers or reward games), while the best reel displays a multiplier (varying from 2x approximately 50x).
- **The Result:** If the symbol on the left reel matches the result of the main wheel spin, the multiplier is used to that win. If it points to a bonus game, the multiplier applies to all multipliers inside that specific bonus offer round.

Diving Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The real magic of the video game happens when the wheel arrive at one of the 4 bonus offer sectors. Players who have placed a bet on that specific reward round are transported to a secondary game screen, where enormous multipliers wait for.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the four reward rounds. A coin with a red side and a blue side is turned by a maker. Before the flip, random multipliers are appointed to both sides of the coin. Whichever side lands face up determines the gamer's payment.

- **Perk function:** If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can often be triggered, giving gamers another chance at higher rewards.

2. Cash Hunt

Players exist with an enormous interactive screen displaying a shooting gallery with 108 random multipliers concealed behind different signs (like a cactus, target, or sheriff's badge).

- **The Gameplay:** Players use a virtual cannon to intend and contend one sign before a countdown timer expires. Once the timer ends, all signs reveal their covert multipliers, and the player is awarded the multiplier they strike.

3. Pachinko

Influenced by the traditional Japanese arcade game, Pachinko features a big wall filled with physical pegs.



- **The Gameplay:** The live host drops a puck from the top of the wall. As the puck cascades downward, it bounces arbitrarily off the pegs before landing in one of several multiplier zones at the bottom. If the puck arrive on a "DOUBLE" zone, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again.

4. Crazy Time

The ultimate benefit round. Players stroll through a red door into a surreal, virtual world including a huge, 64-segment mega wheel.

- **The Gameplay:** The player (or the host, depending upon the video game version) picks one of three flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the picked flapper indicate is awarded. Like Pachinko, this wheel likewise includes "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" sections, enabling fortunate gamers to set off huge wins as much as the game's cap of 20,000 x.

Tips and Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is essentially a video game of chance dictated by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and physical physics, gamers typically use different techniques to manage their bankroll and maximize home entertainment.

- **The Conservative Approach (Number Betting):**
 - Focus mostly on betting numbers 1 and 2, which make up a large part of the wheel. This technique yields regular, smaller sized wins, keeping the bankroll stable and extending playtime.
- **The Balanced Approach (Covering Bonuses):**
 - Spread small bets across all 4 bonus offer rounds while sometimes backing number 10. This ensures eligibility for the high-paying reward games without draining pipes funds too rapidly.
- **The High-Volatility Approach (Bonus Hunting):**
 - Place bets solely on the bonus offer rounds (Cash Hunt, Pachinko, Crazy Time, Coin Flip). This design needs patience and a bigger bankroll, as droughts can take place, but it offers direct access to the game's greatest potential payments.

Finest Practices for Responsible Gaming

1. **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed total up to spend before beginning the game and never ever chase losses.
2. **Understand the RTP:** Keep in mind that bonus offer bets generally have a somewhat lower RTP than simple number bets, implying they are greater threat, greater reward.
3. **Delight in the Show:** Treat the wagering expense as the cost of admission to an interactive game show. The main objective must always be entertainment.
