The most typical market tier. **Well-Worn (WW)** 0.38-- 0.45 Substantial wear, fading colors, and prominent scratches. **Battle-Scarred (BS)** 0.45-- 1.00 Heavily distressed, rusted, or scraped. Some skins look totally various (and distinctively gritty) in this condition.

Loadouts in CS2 are classified by weapon types, with players typically picking a primary rifle (AK-47 for Terrorists, M4A4 or M4A1-S for Counter-Terrorists), a sniper rifle (AWP), and sidearms.
