Without a specific theme to follow, focus on the mood you're aiming for. Do you want it to be cozy and intimate? High-energy and fun? Relaxed and easygoing?

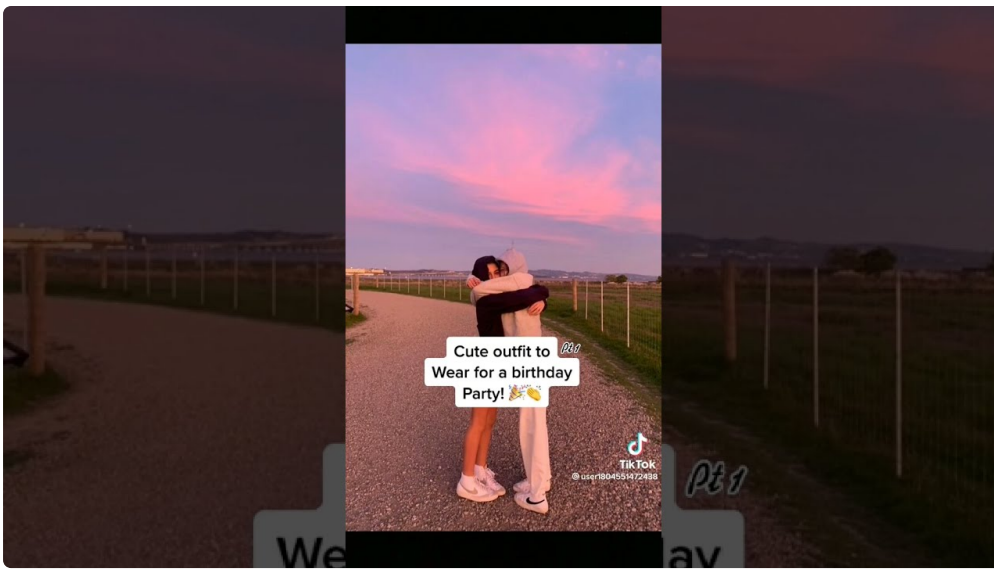
Use this thinking to inform your decisions for design elements, music, engagement, and the menu.
