They'll draw on their knowledge to make decisions about the room setup, the aesthetics, the food, and the performances.

Managing the Event Itself

On the day of the event, your planner will be the one managing all the moving parts even though the birthday person hasn't previewed the venue.

They'll have backup options in case the guest of honor has objections and they'll be prepared to adapt quickly.
