Second, hourly labor rates jump significantly; a technician working midnight plumbing calls earns substantially more than one clocking in at 8 a.m. Third, if your emergency requires parts replacement, expedited sourcing may add a premium if the repair demands materials not immediately in stock. Fourth, some emergency plumbers charge a surcharge for holidays or extreme after-hours windows (3 a.m. calls typically cost more than 10 p.m. ones).
