A "double take" regimen will be as essential as: coin looks in a single hand, then any other hand "proves" it wasn't there, then a surprise region happens returned. The trick is not the stream, it's the beat timing. People suppose magic is quick. Real magic is paced. You supply them a moment to take a look at the incorrect thing, then you definitely move even as they're processing.

If you favor a signature sense, add a character hook: a funny story that buys you your typical pause, or a line that reframes what they just saw.
