

Riverwalk in Jupiter has a character that reveals itself slowly. The streets feel lived in, the landscaping is thoughtful without being showy, and the neighborhood sits close enough to the town's larger rhythm that you can step into a quieter pocket without losing access to restaurants, parks, and coastal energy.
