Idea: Look for platforms that release a "provably fair" hash for each battle. This allows players to individually confirm that the outcome was not changed after the truth.

4. Kinds Of Case Battle Giveaways

- **Arranged Giveaways**-- Occur at a set time each day (e.g., 8 PM UTC). Gamers should sign up before the start.
- **Immediate Giveaways**-- Randomly triggered after any case battle concludes; winners are drawn quickly from the swimming pool of individuals.
