2. Recoil Case

For players chasing after colorful, anime-inspired, or lively sci-fi visual appeals, the **Prisma 2 Case** is a top contender.

- **Standout Skins:** M4A1-S|Gamer Two, AK-47|Phantom Disruptor.
- **Why it's terrific:** The M4A1-S|Gamer Two is a fan-favorite amongst gamers who prefer lively, dynamic styles over military-sim visual appeals. Paired with Horizon-series knives, it offers a terrific balance of price and visual appeal.

4. Operation Broken Fang Case

Operations always present renowned cases, and **Broken Fang** stands out due to its addition of representative skins (at the time) and high-demand weapon surfaces.

- **Standout Skins:** M4A4|Cyber Security, AWP|Exoskeleton.
- **Why it's excellent:** This case includes the specialized glove pool rather of standard knives. Gloves like Driver Gloves|Snow Leopard and Specialist Gloves|Marble Fade remain a few of the most desired products in the video game, keeping the worth of this case steadily climbing up.

5. CS20 Case
