The Anatomy of Opening a Case

To open a CS2 case, a player needs 2 things: the case itself and a **Container Key**. Keys are offered evenly in-game by Valve for a flat rate of £ 2.50 GBP (or local equivalent).

As soon as a key is utilized on a case, a roulette-style wheel spins through the possible weapon skins included within that particular drop. The item the wheel stops on is permanently contributed to the gamer's inventory.

What are the Odds?

Valve does not clearly release the precise chances in-game for each region due to varying local gaming laws, however extensive neighborhood data tracking countless openings has actually revealed reliable estimates for drop rarity.



Rarity Tier Color Code Approximate Drop Rate **Mil-Spec (Common)** Blue ~ 79.92% **Restricted (Uncommon)** Purple ~ 15.98% **Classified (Rare)** Pink ~ 3.20% **Covert (Mythical)** Red ~ 0.64% **Special Item (Exceedingly Rare)** Gold ~ 0.26%

Active Service vs. Rare Case Pools

Valve periodically updates the case drop system, classifying cases into two unique swimming pools:

1. **The Active Drop Pool:** These cases drop frequently to gamers ending up matches and earning weekly care packages.
2. **The Rare (Discontinued) Pool:** When a new case is presented or an operation ends, older cases are transferred to the uncommon pool. They no longer drop regularly after matches, though players still have an incredibly small opportunity (approximated at under 1%) of receiving one as a reward drop. Since their supply is limited, rare cases often value in worth in time.

With lots of cases launched over the lifespan of CS: GO and CS2, certain collections stand apart due to their renowned skins or high-tier knives.
