

Garage Door Repair Services in Los Angeles

A dependable garage door is important for security, ease, and daily entry to your home. Local **garage door repair** services in Los Angeles typically cover inspection, adjustment, maintenance, parts replacement, and complete door installation. Typical Garage Door Problems in Southern California Homes

Los Angeles weather is generally pleasant, but heat, strong sun exposure, dust, and temperature changes still influence garage doors. Ultraviolet exposure can dehydrate rubber components, while dust can build up on rollers, hinges, tracks, and opener mechanisms. A garage that faces afternoon sun may experience more rapid breakdown of its weather seal and bottom seal than a shaded installation.

A **broken garage door spring** is one of the most common reasons a door suddenly fails. Other frequent problems include a damaged **garage door panel**, a failed **garage door opener**, and a bent or obstructed **garage door track**. If the door is loud, uneven, slow, or jerks during movement, continued operation may turn a small repair into a more expensive one.

Do not operate a door that is unusually heavy or appears crooked. A broken spring or detached cable can allow the door to drop unexpectedly. If the door will not open, disconnecting the opener and attempting manual lifting without professional guidance can create a danger, particularly with a wide two-car door.

When You Need Garage Door Spring Replacement

Springs balance the weight of the door. A **torsion spring** is mounted above the door and rotates as the door moves, while an **extension spring** stretches along the horizontal tracks. Both types can fail after repeated cycles. Signs of failure include a loud snap, a visible gap in the spring, a door that feels extremely heavy, or a door that rises only a few inches.

The correct replacement depends on the door’s weight, height, track configuration, and existing hardware. Springs should not be selected by appearance alone. Test the **safety photo-eye** and the **door safety sensor** periodically. The two sensors should be aligned with each other across the opening, with dust-free lenses and no obstruction. If the door will not reverse when an object is placed in its path according to the manufacturer's instructions, discontinue use and arrange service.

Inspect the weather seal and bottom seal for damage, gaps, or compression. Sun and heat can stiffen rubber, allowing dust, insects, and hot air into the garage. Keep tracks [EM Garage Garage Door & Opener Brands](#) free of debris, but do not apply grease indiscriminately. Use only products approved for the components, and ask a technician about lubrication for rollers, hinges, and bearings.



Preventive maintenance should include checking balance, fasteners, cables, rollers, track alignment, spring condition, the wall switch, remote control, and motor unit.
