What to Think About When Deciding on Plus-Ones

1. Space Constraints

The most practical consideration is location limit. Should your venue can easily hold 50 people and you have fifty guests on your list, partners simply are unable to be accommodated.

Second. Budget

Every additional visitor augments to your expense — food, drink, seating, and gifts. If your budget is tight, you may need to restrict significant others.

3. Relationship Closeness

Take into account how near you are to each guest. Intimate friends and family generally deserve a plus-one. Colleagues may not.

Fourth. Social Dynamics

Take into account whether guests will know anyone else at the party. If a guest will know nobody, a plus-one can assist them feel more at ease.

Conveying Your Plus-One Policy

1. Be Unambiguous

Indicate your plus-one approach distinctly on the invite. For example: "We have reserved two seats in your honour." Another option: "We regret that we cannot accommodate additional guests."



Second. Apply the Same Rule to Everyone

Third. Anticipate Enquiries

A number of guests will ask whether they can include a plus-one. Be courteous but unwavering. By way of illustration: "I'm so sorry, but we have limited space and can only accommodate the guests named on the invitation."

4. Consider a Compromise

If you want to include partners but are limited by finances or capacity, look into a compromise — such as extending an invitation to plus-ones only for the late-night portion of the night.
