Features to Look for in a Case Battle Site With lots of websites providing case battles, how does one separate the genuine platforms from the scams? Readers must always examine sites based on the following criteria: Provably Fair Systems: A reliable site need to utilize

a cryptographic algorithm (Provably Fair)that permits users to validate that the result of every case opening was totally random and not controlled by the house. Withdrawal Speed & Liquidity: Winning skins is terrific, but getting them into your Steam stock rapidly is
