

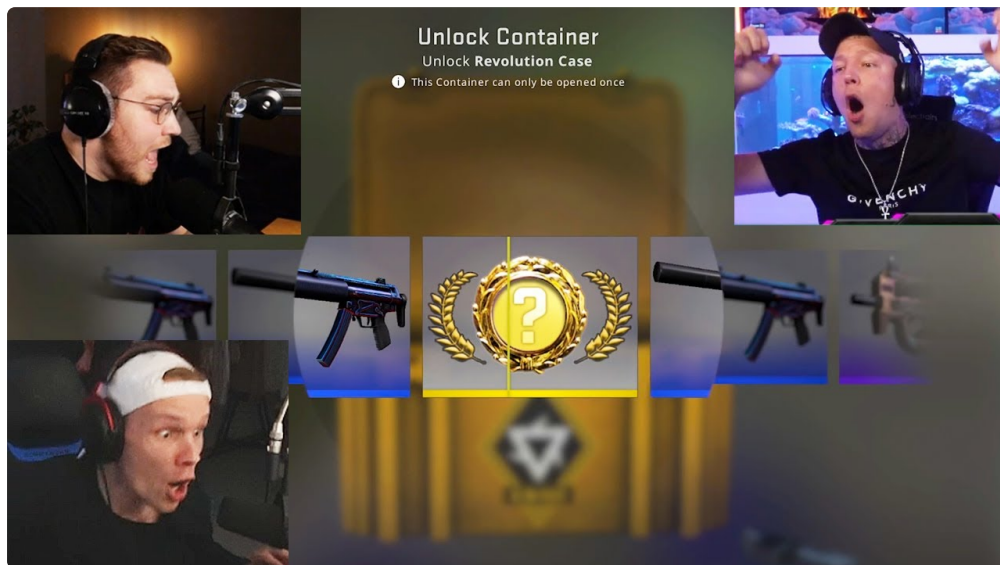

How Does a Case Battle Work?
