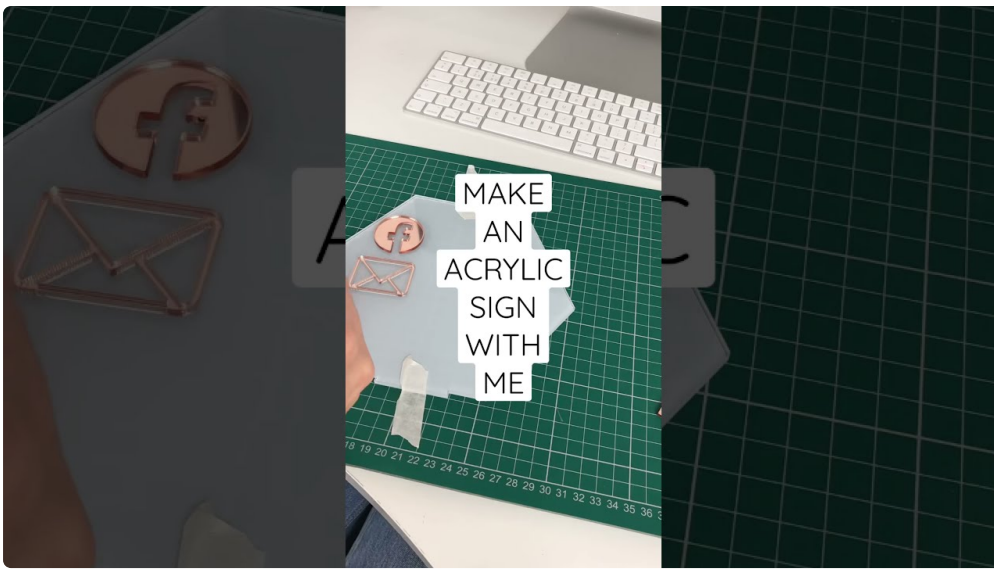

We shifted to a satin black backer panel with a good two inch border, floated off the stone with the aid of 3 quarters of an inch. The stainless letters mounted to the panel with blank, even halo lighting round their edges, and the black box saved legibility reliable. The Jstomer kept the stone, which they beloved, and received a sign that seemed intention developed as opposed to pressured.

At a tech startup, the lobby changed into compact, with a tumbler front and direct solar within the morning. They desired illuminated channel letters inside the company's cool blue. Under daylight, the face lit letters would have washed out, and the LEDs would be visible as dots. We advisable dimensional acrylic letters with an aluminum face, aspect lit from a backer frame to create a crisp blue ring at evening and a solid metal study by using day. It charge less than a full channel letter build and done larger in that light.

In a healthcare putting, cleansing protocols depend. We shunned porous woods and frustrating seams, opting for painted acrylic with radiused edges on a seamless backer. We established every little thing with hidden hardware and used a satin finish that resists streaking. The amenities group preferred that the everyday wipe down took seconds and left no water marks.

## Coordinating with broader industrial signage
