Healthy Movement Habits for Every Age

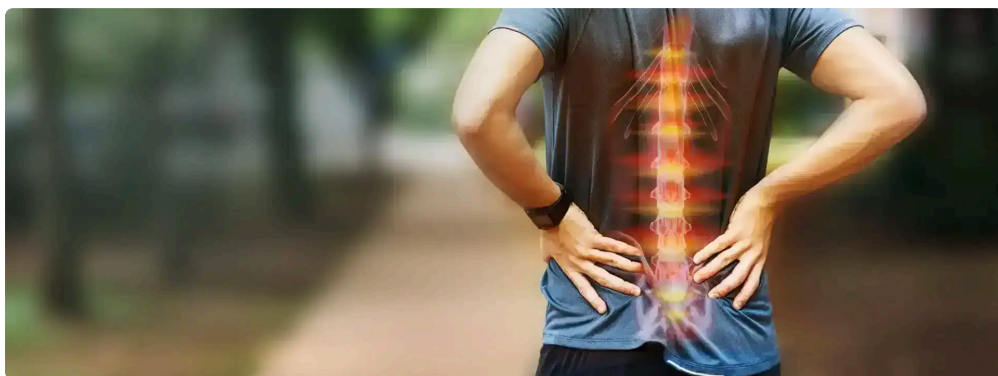

- **Paying attention to workstation setup:** Position screens, chairs, and desks to reduce unnecessary strain.
- **Using backpacks appropriately:** Children should use both shoulder straps and avoid carrying unnecessary weight.
- **Building strength gradually:** Appropriate strengthening can support joints and improve tolerance for daily activities.
- **Using good lifting mechanics:** Avoid awkward twisting and use the legs when lifting heavier objects.
- **Taking symptoms seriously:** Persistent pain, weakness, numbness, or significant changes in mobility should be appropriately evaluated.
