

The drum seal stands as the most expensive washing machine component to replace, typically costing \$400–\$800 in parts and labor combined. We also check for vertical play in the drum shaft; excessive movement signals that the bearing assembly is separating from the seal. This test takes two minutes but eliminates guesswork.
