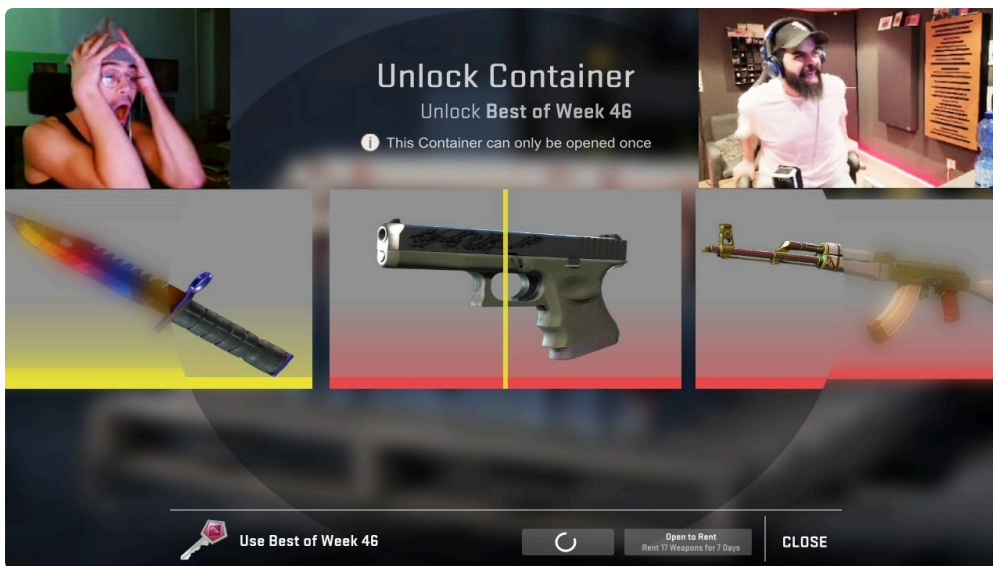

Note: The exact likelihood for a specific knife (e.g., Karambit|Fade) is a portion of the uncommon unique item pool.

These numbers illustrate that the overwhelming majority of openings will produce standard skins, not knives. The low probability makes knife openings a high-risk, high-reward activity.
