If a product requires a recoat among 2 and 6 hours, we do no longer wait until hour 10 without a light scuff. That discipline is what maintains blocking and print-due to at bay.

Tannin bleed with the aid of knotty or stained woods can ghost as a result of even two coats of prevalent primer. Color transparency catches many owners off defend. Color, sheen, and layout decisions

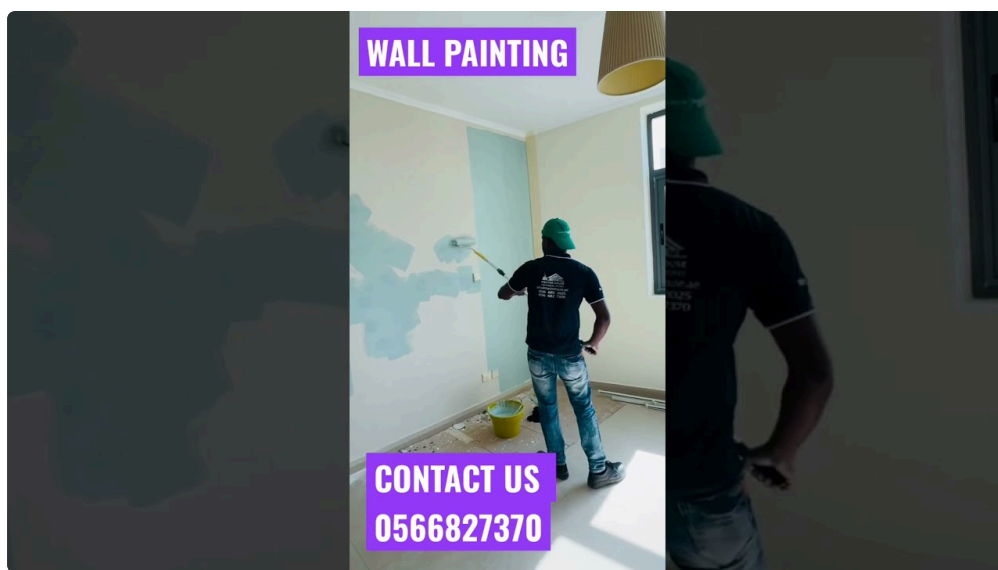

We eliminated 28 doors and 12 drawers, wiped clean, deglossed, and notice-primed with a tannin blocker wherein vital. Frames obtained a bonding primer and a high-construct surfacer. We sanded profiles with foam

pads and shot two topcoats of satin urethane. Doors were sprayed flat in the shop with the equal system. Hardware holes have been filled and re-drilled to change from three-inch pulls to 5-inch, which required a jig and persistence to store strains immediately.

From arrival to remaining wipe-down took 8 working days. At day 3 after rehang, the conclude felt dry however we nevertheless entreated mild use for about a weeks. Six months later the buyer which is called, not with a grievance, yet to time table ceiling portray services inside the adjacent domestic room considering the fact that the cupboards made the old ceiling appearance drained.
