What Registration Requirements Lock In Your Parts Warranty?

Most manufacturers require you to register your HVAC equipment within a specific window—often 30 to 90 days from installation—to activate the full parts warranty. Failure to meet this registration requirement means you may only receive a limited warranty, typically covering defects for one year instead of five to ten years. Many homeowners in neighborhoods like Greenhaven and Pocket discover this too late, when a compressor fails and they learn their warranty was never activated.

How Does Proof of Maintenance Preserve Labor and Parts Coverage?

Labor warranty—the manufacturer's commitment to cover repair or replacement labor costs—typically lasts two to five years, but it vanishes if you cannot demonstrate regular maintenance. Manufacturers include this requirement because dirty filters, blocked vents, and low refrigerant levels accelerate component failure. They protect themselves by requiring documented annual or biennial tune-ups performed by licensed contractors.

A typical manufacturer parts warranty covers defects in the compressor, condenser coil, and evaporator coil for ten years from the registration date. However, this coverage is conditional: the system must have received annual maintenance, all repairs must have been documented by licensed technicians, and you must provide proof when

filing a claim. Some manufacturers offer extended labor warranties of two to five years, but only if the system was installed by a licensed contractor and registered within the required timeframe.

Understanding these boundaries matters because a ten-year parts warranty does not mean your system will operate perfectly for ten years. It means that if a covered component fails due to a manufacturing defect—not wear and tear, not user neglect—the manufacturer will replace it at no charge.
