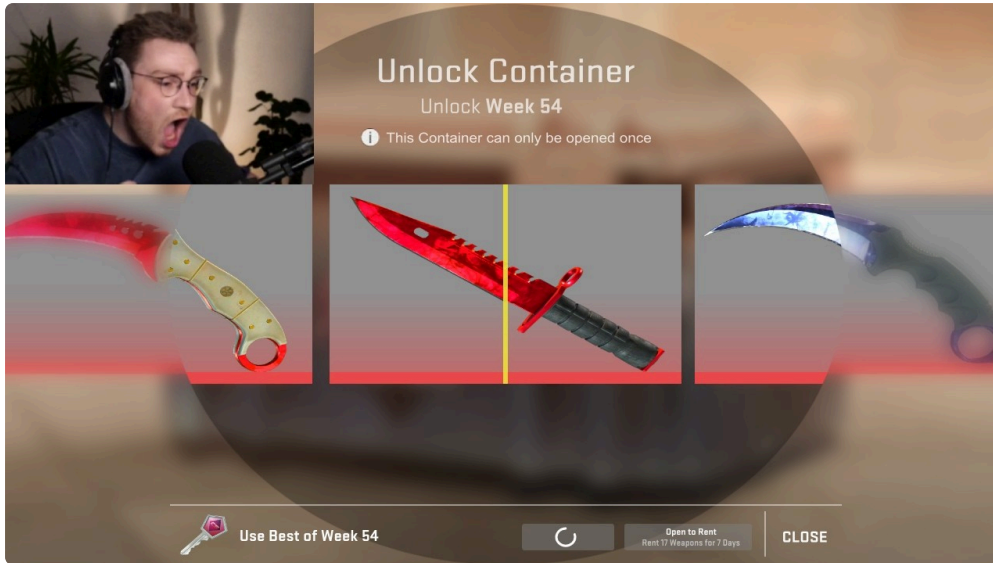

- **Prioritize "Gold" Items**-- If your objective is to acquire the limited-time Gold skin, target the case that offers the highest drop rate for that rarity tier.

Market Reaction and Future Outlook

The introduction of the 5 new cases has triggered a noticeable rise in general case-opening activity.
