2. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli System)

- **How it works:** You double your bet after every **win**, and reset to your base bet after every **loss**.
- **Objective:** Ride a hot streak of 3 to 4 wins in a row, then squander and reset. This safeguards your core balance while letting the house's cash trip throughout a streak.

3. The Low Multiplier Auto-Cashout Strategy (Conservative)
