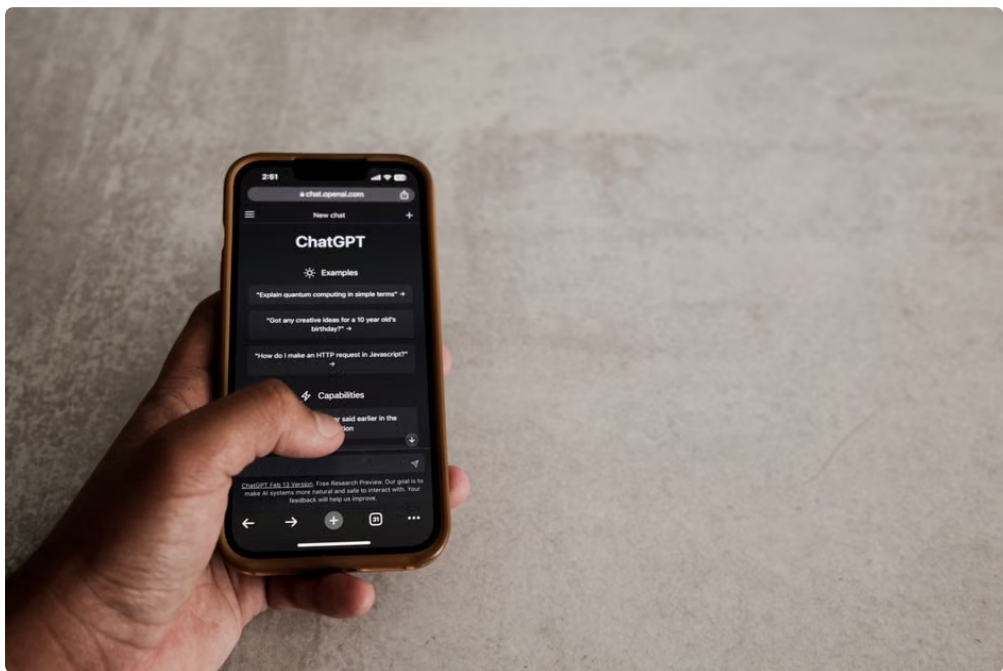

What's the Failure Mode?

I'll be honest with you: this question is always critical for professional ai tool evals:
