Unlike traditional table video games like blackjack or roulette, Crazy Time requires no complex memorization of rules or method charts. Gamers simply put bets on where they think the wheel will stop, making it available to outright beginners while still offering the high volatility and enormous win potential that experienced gamblers yearn for.

How the Game is Played

Every game round starts with a wagering stage. Gamers have a minimal time to position their chips on several of the 8 readily available betting alternatives on the virtual layout. These choices include four numbers (1, 2, 5, and 10) and 4 distinct reward video games.

Once betting closes, the live host spins the huge wheel. All at once, a separate two-reel slot placed above the primary wheel-- understood as the **Top Slot**-- spins along with it.

The Top Slot Mechanism

Before the wheel stops, the Top Slot produces a random multiplier <https://bitz.io/games/crazy-time> and designates it to among the 8 betting alternatives on the wheel.

- If the Top Slot multiplier and the wheel result align on the very same section, the multiplier applies to that win.

- If the result is a perk game, the multiplier improves all the multipliers *inside* that specific bonus round, causing potentially astronomical payments.

Understanding the Wheel Segments and Payouts

The 54 sections on the Crazy Time wheel are distributed among numbers and benefit video games. Naturally, the lower-paying numbers appear a lot more frequently on the wheel than the rare perk rounds.

Breakdown of Wheel Segments

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times (Payout: 1:1)
- **Number 2:** Appears 13 times (Payout: 2:1)
- **Number 5:** Appears 7 times (Payout: 5:1)
- **Number 10:** Appears 4 times (Payout: 10:1)
- **Coin Flip Bonus:** Appears 4 times
- **Cash Hunt Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Pachinko Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Crazy Time Bonus:** Appears 1 time

Dive Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The true magic-- and the source of the video game's most significant payments-- lies within its 4 interactive bonus rounds. Whenever the wheel arrive at a benefit sector, players who placed a bet on that specific feature are carried to a secondary video game screen.



1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the 4 bonuses, this round features a coin with a red side and a blue side.

- Each side is designated a random multiplier before the flip.
- The host presses a button to turn the coin, and whichever color lands face-up awards the matching multiplier to the player's bet.

2. Cash Hunt

This is a giant interactive shooting gallery including a screen with 108 random multipliers concealed behind different symbols (like a cactus, target, or chef's hat).

- Players utilize a virtual crosshair to intend and shoot at a sign of their choice before a countdown timer ends.
- As soon as time goes out, all signs reveal their covert multipliers, and the gamer wins whatever worth they shot.

3. Pachinko

Influenced by the conventional Japanese arcade game, Pachinko features a big wall filled with physical pegs.

- The host drops a puck from the top of the board.
- The puck bounces randomly down the pegs up until it lands in among the slots at the bottom, which contains a multiplier.
- If the puck lands in a **"DOUBLE"** slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again for an even bigger payout.

4. Crazy Time

The crown jewel of the game. When activated, the host opens a red door leading into a surreal, brilliantly colored virtual world including an enormous, 64-segment mega-wheel.

- Gamers need to choose one of 3 flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow**.
- The host spins the wheel, and the flapper the gamer chosen identifies their prize.
- This wheel features **"DOUBLE"** and **"TRIPLE"** segments. If the flapper indicate one of these, all multipliers on the wheel multiply, and the wheel spins again-- enabling wins to scale approximately the video game's maximum cap of 500,000 x!

Methods for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is ultimately a video game of chance determined by RNG and physics, gamers frequently employ various wagering techniques to handle their bankroll and optimize their time playing.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:** Betting heavily on the numbers (1 and 2) alongside a little cover bet on the bonus rounds. This approach yields frequent, smaller sized wins, keeping the bankroll stable for longer periods.
- **The Bonus-Only Strategy:** Ignoring the numbers totally and positioning little bets specifically on the four reward rounds (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time). This technique is high-risk, high-reward, as it depends on striking the relatively rare bonus offer sections to see a return.
- **The Spread Strategy:** Placing bets across a variety of sectors (numbers and perks alike) to make sure that a high percentage of the wheel yields some form of return.

Necessary Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a repaired home entertainment budget before visiting and never ever chase losses.
- **Understand Volatility:** Bonus rounds do not struck on every spin. Expect droughts while waiting for a perk to set off.
- **Play for Entertainment:** Remember that live casino video games are created mostly for fun and home entertainment, not as a dependable source of income.
