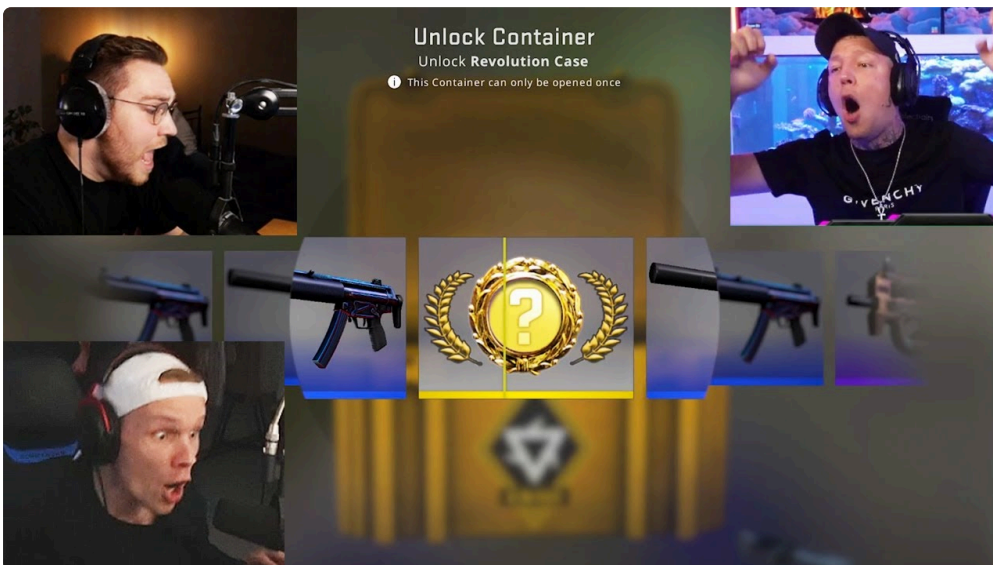


CSGO Case Battle Giveaways: How They Work, Where to Participate, and Tips for Safe Play

Tip: Look for platforms that publish a "provably reasonable" hash for each battle. This allows players to individually validate that the result was not modified after the fact.

4. Types of Case Battle Giveaways

- **Set up Giveaways**-- Occur at a set time each day (e.g., 8 PM UTC). Players should register before the start.
- **Instantaneous Giveaways**-- Randomly set off after any case battle concludes; winners are drawn quickly from the pool of individuals.
