2. The Martingale Strategy (Progression Betting)

- **The Strategy:** Double your bet every time you lose, and go back to your base bet when you win.
- **The Goal:** Recover all previous losses with a single win plus a revenue equal to the base bet.
- **The Risk:** This needs a huge bankroll and can quickly hit platform optimum bet limits or diminish your funds during an extended losing streak.

3. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli System)

- **The Strategy:** Double your bet after every *win*, and return to the base bet after a loss.
- **The Goal:** Ride a hot streak to maximize revenues while lessening risk during cold streaks.
- **The Risk:** You need to manually squander at a reasonable multiplier (like 2.00 x) consistently for this to work.
