

If you are located in Brampton and suspect something unusual is moving above the ceiling, squirrels are one of the most common culprits. In standalone homes, side-by-side homes, and older rooflines across Peel Region, these animals often use small gaps to reach attics and start roof nesting before homeowners notice.
