Papillomas		Small outgrowths of the upper layer of the skin or mucous membrane, located on a thin stalk and have a cylindrical shape. Most often, the color does not differ from the color of the skin, but can also acquire various shades of brown. The reason for the appearance of such benign formations is the human papillomavirus (HPV), more than 100 strains of which have been found.	They occur most often in the neck, armpits and genitals, but can form anywhere on the body.

Viral warts		Horny dense and dry elevations with an uneven villous surface. The size can reach 1 cm or more, often merge into large plaques. The color may be flesh, greyish or brown.	Most often localized on the hands and feet, knees, elbows, can also be on the torso, face and scalp.
