The most safe method to browse without guessing

The lure is to grab a shovel and start excavating where your instinct tells you. Often that functions. More often, it wastes time and can harm a shallow pipeline or nick a riser. A far better technique is to confirm the drain line first, then trace it.

A sewage system camera is the cleanest alternative if you have access to one. Feed it from an interior cleanout or pulled bathroom, track the signal above ground, and adhere to the line till it goes into the container. Press straight down, feel resistance, take out, then relocate a few inches and try again. When you hit a wide, level resistance constantly, you may get on top of the tank. When the resistance goes away at the side, you begin to map the container footprint.

If you think the sewer line course yet are not specific, probe in a narrow band along that line rather than across the entire backyard. That reduces your search area drastically.
