Gretna sits in USDA sector 5b, tipping into 6a on favorable micro-sites. That method winter lows can hit the destructive young people. The subsoil usually trends clay with loess loam towards the floor, exceptionally across the older blocks off McKenna Avenue. Newer builds close 204th Street quite often have compacted fill below a skinny topsoil cap. Those two statistics give an explanation for why some well-known imports combat. Blue spruce has a tendency to endure needle cast in our humidity. Red maple appears to be like flashy while planted, then shows chlorosis in alkaline wallet. Prairie natives excel. Purple coneflower, black-eyed Susan, and little bluestem continue up in heat.
