shot two topcoats of satin urethane. Doors had been sprayed flat in the shop with the comparable components. Hardware holes had been stuffed and re-drilled to replace from 3-inch pulls to 5-inch, which required a jig and staying power to stay traces instantly.

From arrival to very last wipe-down took 8 operating days. At day 3 after rehang, the end felt dry however we nonetheless suggested tender use for just a few weeks. Six months later the buyer which is called, now not with a criticism, yet to schedule ceiling portray expertise within the adjacent family members room seeing that the shelves made the antique ceiling appear drained.
