Inside, we tightened the indoor menu to three panels, driven their quality-selling mussels to the top left with a value anchor, and dimmed the menu board by using 30 percent after sunset. The facade felt brighter with out glowing. Reservations held consistent, when bar stroll-ins after eight pm grew through 12 to 15 percentage on weekends. The inspector liked it considering every fastener became concealed, and the associates preferred it for the reason that the light changed into warm.
