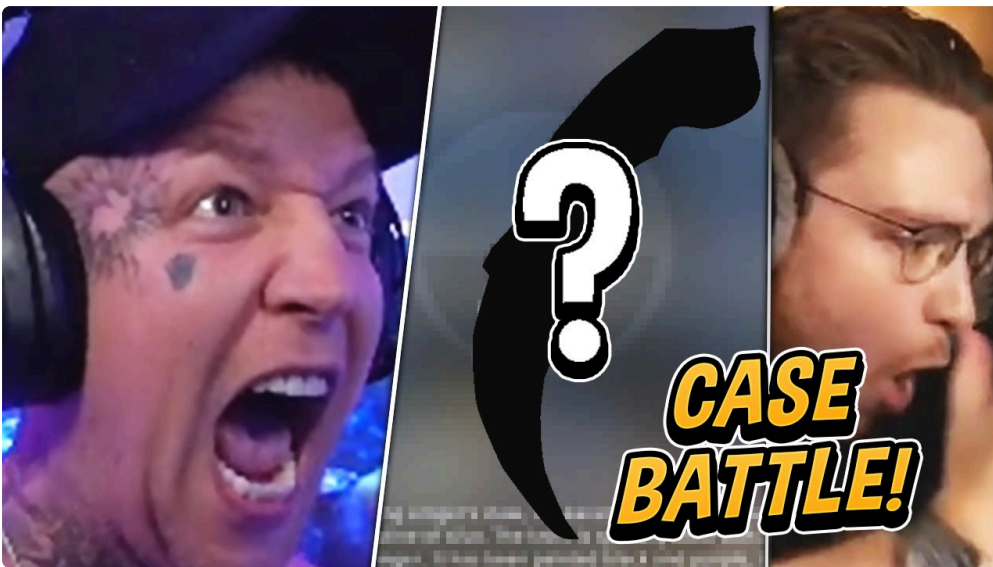


CS2 Case Battles: The Ultimate Guide to the New Competitive Opening Experience
