

Garage Door Repair Services in Pasadena and Los Angeles

Dependable garage door repair protects your home, vehicles, and belongings while maintaining daily routines on schedule. In Pasadena, California, homeowners may need service with a residential garage door, an overhead garage door, a garage door opener, or a damaged door section. - Verify that the manual release works and that household members can operate it during a power outage.
- Assess garage door balance with professional guidance; a door that drops, rises, or feels unusually heavy calls for service.
- Check for frayed garage door cable, loose brackets, bent track sections, cracked rollers, and damaged hinges.
- Check the bottom weather seal for gaps, brittleness, and wind damage.
- Ensure the door's path clear of toys, tools, vehicles, and other obstructions.
- Book an annual inspection for a full safety check, especially on older doors.

Never remove a torsion spring, extension spring, cable, or bottom bracket yourself. These parts store substantial force and can cause serious injury. If the door is stuck open, hanging unevenly, or has fallen from the tracks, keep people and vehicles away and call for emergency repair.
